Monitor ▪ Secure ▪ Dispose

- **Monitor** pills, keep track of refills, and control access. *Many people who abuse prescriptions get them from family and friends.*
- **Secure** pills, preferably in a locked cabinet. *Reduce drug abuse, curb theft, and prevent overdose and accidental poisoning.*
- **Dispose** of unused medications at the permanent disposal sites. *Flushing medications down the toilet or throwing them in the trash is hazardous to humans and animals.*
- **Take** only medications prescribed to you, as directed by your physician. *Sharing or selling a prescription is a crime.*
- **Talk** to your teens about the dangers of abusing prescription drugs.
